HOW ARE HARWICH WATER BILLS CALCULATED?

QUARTERLY BASE RATE: \$35.00 (does not include usage)

ALL <u>WATER USAGE</u> IS BILLED AS FOLLOWS:

TIER 1 \$1.29 per 1,000 gallons for the FIRST 8,000 gallons (0 to 8,000 gallons)

TIER 2 \$2.65 per 1,000 gallons for usage over tier 1 (8,001 to 15,000 gallons)

TIER 3 \$3.95 per 1,000 gallons for usage over tier 2 (15,001 to 40,000 gallons)

TIER 4 \$5.72 per 1,000 gallons for all usage over tier 3 (40,001 gallons +)



Example:

How would I calculate my water bill if I used 86,000 gallons?

Answer:

Water usage is calculated per 1,000 gallons based on the tiers above - for example:

The first 8,000 gallons (of the 86,000) would be multiplied by $$1.29 (8 \times $1.29 = $10.32)$

The next 6,999 gallons would be multiplied by \$2.65 (7* x \$2.65 = \$18.55)

The next 24999 gallons would be multiplied by \$3.95 (25* x \$3.95 = \$98.75)

The remaining 46000 gallons would be multiplied by \$5.72 (46 x \$5.72 = \$263.12)

Add all totals to the \$35.00 base (\$10.32 + \$18.55 +\$98.75+\$263.12) to find the sum \$425.74.
