

HOW ARE HARWICH WATER BILLS CALCULATED?

BASE RATE: \$70.00 (does not include usage)

ALL WATER USAGE IS BILLED AS FOLLOWS:

TIER 1 \$1.29 per 1,000 gallons for the FIRST 15,000 gallons (0 to 15,000 gallons)

TIER 2 \$2.65 per 1,000 gallons for usage over tier 1 (15,001 to 30,000 gallons)

TIER 3 \$3.95 per 1,000 gallons for usage over tier 2 (30,001 to 70,000 gallons)

TIER 4 \$5.72 per 1,000 gallons for all usage over tier 3 (70,001 gallons +)



Example:

How would I calculate my water bill if I used 86,000 gallons?

Answer:

Water usage is calculated per 1,000 gallons based on the tiers above - for example:

The first 15,000 gallons (of the 86,000) would be multiplied by \$1.29 (15 x \$1.29 = **\$19.35**)

The next 14,999 gallons would be multiplied by \$2.65 (15* x \$2.65 = **\$39.75**)

The next 39,999 gallons would be multiplied by \$3.95 (40* x \$3.95 = **\$158.00**)

The remaining 16,000 gallons would be multiplied by \$5.72 (16 x \$5.72 = **\$91.52**)

Add all totals to the \$70.00 base (\$19.35 + \$39.75 + \$158.00 + \$91.52) to find the sum **\$378.62.**
