**Job Description**

Each summer season the Water Department seeks three (3) seasonal laborers to support the increased workload during summer months. The primary and distinct responsibility of the seasonal laborer positions sought each season is to landscape over 2,126 acres of Water Department property and assist in the maintenance of over 1,300 Hydrants.

**Essential Functions**

- Mows, weeds, trims and rakes;
- Seeds, loams, plants, waters;
- Trims and cuts trees, hedges, shrubbery;
- Picks up and disposes of rubbish and leaves
- Clean, lubricate, & paint hydrants

**Requirements**

- Must be 18, or able to obtain a work permit
- Must have reliable transportation to/from work
- Experience in operating a variety of landscaping and turf equipment.
- Self-motivated and ability to work effectively independently.
- Demonstrates good workmanship in a neat and timely manner.

**Knowledge, Skills and Abilities**

- Ability to read and write English;
- Ability to follow instruction, procedures and safety precautions;
- Ability to report for work on time and perform the duties of the job for a complete workday;
- Skill in operating lawn mowers, weed trimmers and a variety of light power and hand tools;
- Ability to perform landscaping duties under varying weather conditions for long periods of time.
- Ability to work while wearing personal protective equipment such as a work boots, rain gear, hard hats, safety glasses, ear protection, etc.

**Salary**

The pay range for this position is \$14.00-\$16.00 per hour depending on experience.

**Hours**

This is a full-time seasonal position with hours of 7:00 – 3:30 p.m. Monday thru Friday during the summer months. Position will not to exceed 16 weeks.
